- Provides anonymous, evidence-based, self-conducted screenings available online 24 hours a day

How Are You Feeling?

Behavioral health – which includes mental health, substance use, and more – is a key part of your overall well-being. Brief screenings are the quickest way to determine if you or someone you care about should connect with a behavioral health professional. Think of these as a checkup from your neck up. This program is completely anonymous and confidential, and immediately following the brief questionnaire you will see your results, recommendations, and key resources.



USING ACCESS POINT IS EASY

The image above is the first thing you see when you use the Access Point program. You do not have to give your name or provide any other personal details to take part.

By answering a few simple questions, you can learn more about what you or someone you know may be going through. Although Access Point does not provide a diagnosis, it can share whether you should seek more information to get help.

ACCESS POINT KIOSKS

Trillium has several kiosks—privacy booths—in communities we serve. They meet current Americans with Disability (ADA) requirements if you use a wheelchair or walker.

These kiosks offer you the opportunity to:

- Sit down to use the program to take a screening or look up resources
- Take a wallet card with the Access Point web address for logging into the program at home
