- **5,572 community members QPR trained to prevent suicide** and provide next steps for individuals

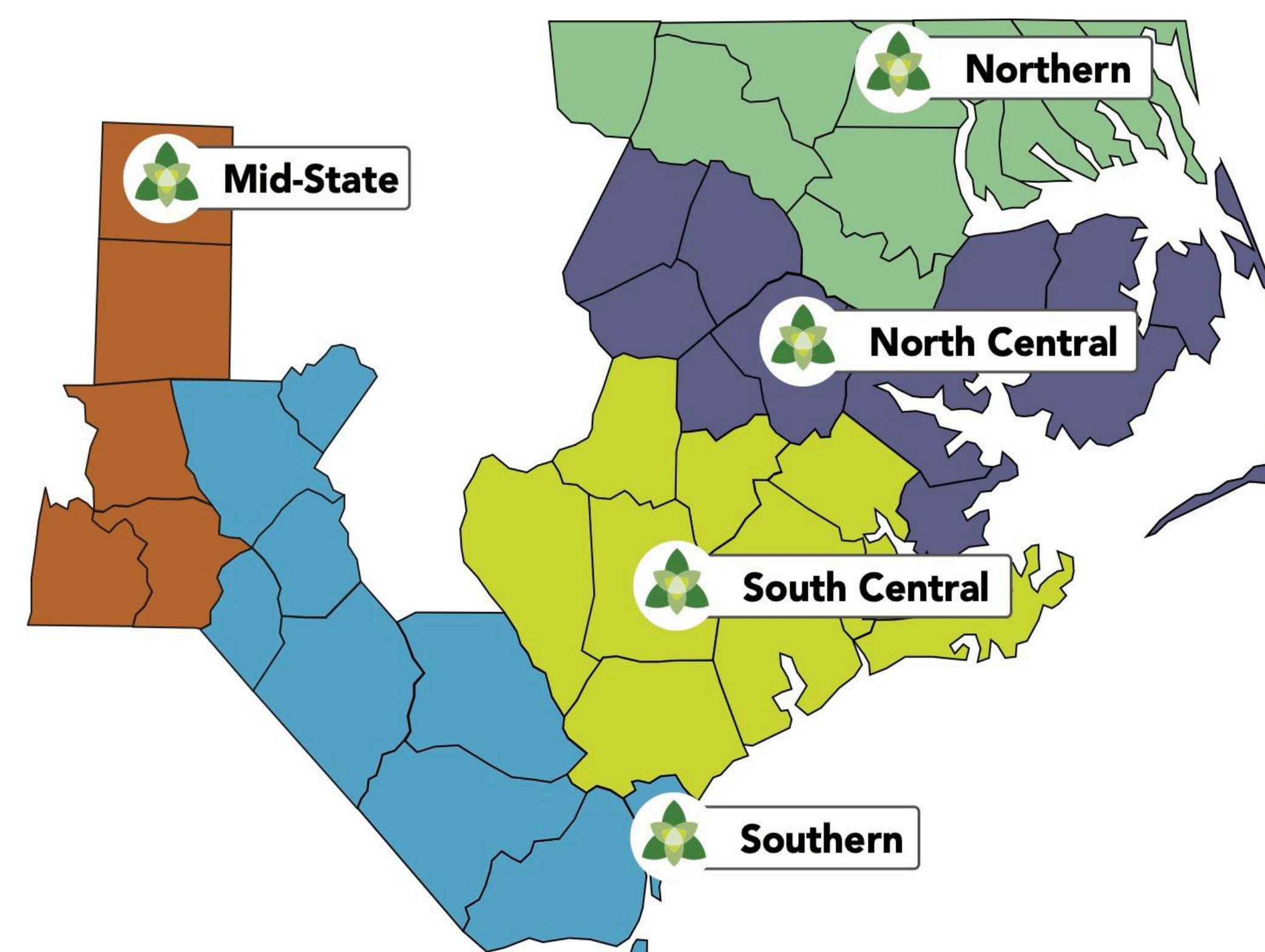
