Description	<b>Intellectual/Developmental Disability (I/DD) Care Coordinator</b> is responsible for providing complex coordination and monitoring to individuals having a primary Intellectual or Developmental Disability, which may include a secondary mental health or substance abuse, and/or complex medical/physical health need. This position requires a dynamic, proactive approach to assessment, monitoring and coordination of care, to ensure quality supports and consistent adherence to waiver requirements. This position has a primary focus on working with children that have a Dual Diagnosis (IDD/MH/SU); serving primarily individuals 21 years and younger.
Requirements	<p><b>Education:</b> A graduate of a college or university with a Master’s degree in a human service field and has one year of full-time, post-graduate degree accumulated experience with the I/DD population, or a graduate of a college or university with a bachelor's degree in a human service field and has two years of full-time, post-bachelor's degree accumulated I/DD experience, or a graduate of a college or university with a bachelor's degree in a field other than human services and has four years of full-time, post-bachelor's degree accumulated I/DD experience.</p> <p><b>Experience:</b> Documented experience working with individuals with intellectual and/or developmental disabilities specifically that are under the age of 21, and Dually Diagnosed IDD/ MH/SU is <u>highly preferred</u>. Experience with a CAP/Innovations waiver population is <u>preferred</u>.</p> <p>Must have valid driver’s license.</p>
