**Subject:** Changes in timelines to process TARs beginning January 1, 2026

### CHANGES IN TIMELINES TO PROCESS TARs

This bulletin is to inform you of the upcoming changes related to timelines to process TARs beginning January 1, 2026. Per CMS-0057F Interoperability and Prior Authorization Rule, timelines to process standardized TARs will be moved from 14 days to 7 days.

Trillium will also be required to publicly report certain metrics about their prior authorization processes, on their public website on an annual basis. This includes the percentage of prior authorization requests approved, denied, and approved after appeal, and average time between submission and decision.

As a reminder, please submit all clinical documents at the time of the request so we can make timely decisions in the shorter timeframe.
