Tailored Plans will coordinate integrated services for physical and serious behavioral health care needs, with a launch date of July 1, 2022.

Medicaid members and state-funded recipients do not need to do anything at this time. Over the next year, we will share opportunities for members and recipients to learn about changes to procedures, new services available, and what to expect. 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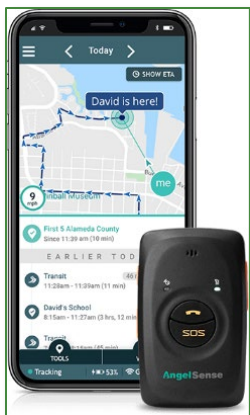
