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### **MATCH LEARNING COLLABORATIVE**

DMHDDSAS has announced the second MATCH Learning Collaborative will start in August 2020 with the release of the provider application in May 2020. MATCH is an evidence-based outpatient psychotherapy for children and adolescents ages 6-15 that targets the most common presenting behavioral concerns and can be utilized with nearly 80% of children served in typical community-based settings. The children and adolescents who will be served in outpatient therapy in the Tailored Plan will have complex and multiple mental health diagnoses which can be addressed in the flexible MATCH model.
