NCDHHS ANNOUNCES UPDATED LAUNCH FOR BEHAVIORAL HEALTH I/DD TAILORED PLANS

NCDHHS [has announced](#) that Behavioral Health and Intellectual/Developmental Disabilities (I/DD) Tailored Plans will launch Dec. 1, 2022, instead of July 1, 2022. Individuals who need certain services to address a serious mental illness, serious emotional disturbance, severe substance use disorder, I/DD or TBI, may be eligible to enroll in a Behavioral Health I/DD Tailored Plan. This updated implementation schedule will provide NCDHHS and the Local Management Entities/Managed Care Organizations (LME/MCOs) with the additional time necessary to address the complexities of a high-quality system to care for and treat individuals with mental health and substance use disorders, I/DD and traumatic brain injuries (TBI).

UPDATED PROVIDER ENROLLMENT TRAINING

This fall, NC Medicaid is releasing an updated series of provider enrollment training videos, which are required components of the provider enrollment process for North Carolina Medicaid providers, and mandated under NCGS108C-9 (c). Public Consulting Group (PCG) is the state contractor responsible for conducting the pre-enrollment trainings for all newly enrolling providers.

The seven-part series covers current policies and procedures under the new NC Medicaid Managed Care guidelines. To complete the coursework, providers must watch each video, complete each quiz and pass the final exam with a 70% score or better.

TAILORED CARE MANAGEMENT 101 WEBINAR SERIES

Tailored Care Management will be the predominant care management model for the Behavioral Health and Intellectual/Developmental Disability (I/DD) Tailored Plan population, which includes individuals with significant behavioral health conditions (including serious mental illness, serious emotional disturbances and severe substance use disorders), I/DD and traumatic brain injury (TBI). Tailored Plan members will obtain care management through one of three approaches: through an Advanced Medical Home Plus (AMH+) practice, Care Management Agency (CMA), or a care manager based at a Tailored Plan.

[The Tailored Care Management 101 webinar](#) series was designed to help develop a shared understanding of the model across the North Carolina provider community (including advanced medical homes and behavioral health, I/DD, and TBI providers) and anyone interested.

The webinar series will run from October through mid-December, on Fridays from 12 to 1 p.m., and cover:
