### **Trillium and Project Transition hold ribbon cutting**

*New facility will serve up to 30 individuals with serious mental health or substance use disorders*

WILMINGTON, NC- Trillium Health Resources launched a new facility today in Wilmington with [Project Transition](#). Serving individuals with serious mental health or substance use disorders, the facility will have capacity for up to 30 members. Wilmington Mayor Bill Saffo and New Hanover County Commissioner Rob Zapple attended the ribbon cutting and provided remarks.

Project Transition was founded on the fundamental belief that members can and will thrive in the community if properly and energetically supported. Members are provided an independent living opportunity, in the community, with other Project Transition members. Each residential program attends its associated Outpatient/Day Program location (consisting of offices and group rooms) for skill workshops, medication management, therapies, meetings, and other core psychiatric rehabilitation services provided by a multidisciplinary team.

The facility, located on Doctors Circle, is across the street from the apartment residences where members will live. Participants will take an active role in their recovery, defining what brings meaning to their life and on their own terms.
