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New Inclusive Playground Opens in Bladen County

Joins 32 other playgrounds launched by Trillium

CLARKTON, NC: A new, all-inclusive playground at the Bladen County Playground opened today. Equipment includes a rubber surface to allow for smooth transport with wheelchairs, doublewide ramps to access slides and other elements, and equipment that will appeal to children with sensory issues. The playground will provide an opportunity for individuals of all ages and abilities to play together outside.

Trillium provided \$500,000 to the Bladen County Parks and Recreation Department for the playground, located at 172 Doug Evans Rd. in Clarkton. GameTime[®], the recreation and playground installer selected for the project, uses research-based programs and education to deliver the most tailored play and recreation environments in the world.

"Today we unveil this playground to bring inclusion here for our children and families who experience intellectual and developmental disability, autism, and traumatic brain injury. This playground allows children of all abilities to play together ... this playground, unlike other playgrounds, gives every kid a chance to just be a kid," shared Cindy Ehlers, Chief Operations Officer with Trillium.

Children, their families, county employees, and Trillium staff enjoyed snow cones and music by DJ Smooth after the ribbon cutting.
