Trillium receives MBHO accreditation from NCQA

Demonstrates focus on quality and customer support

GREENVILLE, N.C.—Trillium Health Resources announces that it has earned accreditation from the National Committee for Quality Assurance (NCQA) for Managed Behavioral Healthcare Organization (MBHO).
