Sheron Mosby shared the following:

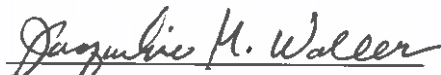
- There were elections done in June. Martha Green remains as Chair; Sheron Mosby is now Vice Chair; Shonnette Ferebee remains as Secretary.
