[REMINDER: QIP's Due July 31](#)

All 2016-2017 Quality Improvement Projects (QIPs) are due on or before 7/31/17. Any fully contracted provider agency with a state contract is required to submit three QIPs for fiscal year 2016-2017. [Quality Improvement Project Peer Review Opportunity](#)

Trillium's Global Quality Improvement Committee offers the option for providers to request a review of their Quality Improvement Projects (QIPs) through a blinded peer review. As part of the review process, the committee will provide feedback regarding how the provider may more fully meet the expectations outlined by Trillium and improve their scores with the next submission. Prior to the committee receiving the QIP for review, Trillium will remove all identifying provider information to ensure the committee does not know who the provider is and to enable the committee to review the QIP impartially.

All QIPs will need to be submitted by 3/31 to be included in the blinded peer review.

NASH COUNTY REALIGNMENT - UPDATE

On November 22, 2016 the Nash County Board of Commissioners voted unanimously to disengage from Eastpointe, and asked for permission to join Trillium Health Resources. On November 28, 2016 the Trillium Governing Board voted unanimously to accept Nash County, if Secretary Brajer of the Department of Health and Human Services granted their request.

The former Secretary and DHHS have authorization to approve a county's request to disengage from its managed care organization. The former Secretary notified Trillium on December 6, 2016 that Nash County was granted the request to disengage from Eastpointe and join Trillium. The effective date of the change will be April 1, 2017.

Trillium has initiated a work plan that has been coordinated with DHHS and Nash County leadership. Trillium hosted events for providers serving Nash County residents, started mailing letters to transitioning Nash County enrollees, and shared information at sessions for key stakeholders and the public.
