2) J232 - Clinical Coverage Policy 8C: Outpatient Behavioral Health Services Provided by Direct-Enrolled Providers

- This JCB is to clarify J232 regarding Nurse Practitioner Credentialing
- This JCB states: "Effective July 1, 2017, Clinical Coverage Policy 8C will be amended" and summarizes the "requirements applicable to NPs not certified as Psychiatric Mental Health Nurse Practitioners (PMHNP)" who want to provide psychiatric services to members with Medicaid (detail within attachment)
- The JCB states: "The PIHP credentialing body and the Medical Director are responsible for assessing the qualifications of Nurse Practitioners not yet certified as Psychiatric Mental Health Nurse Practitioners and for monitoring the supervision and continuing education requirements."
- Trillium is currently reviewing this clarification with the Medical Director and Network Credentialing Team. Updates for the clarified Nurse Practitioner Credentialing will be shared when the new process has been completed.

3) J250 - Clinical Coverage Policy 8A: Enhanced Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services

- "The purpose of this bulletin is to inform the LME-MCOs and providers about changes to Clinical Coverage Policy 8A pertaining to Substance Abuse Intensive Outpatient Program (SAIOP), Substance Abuse Comprehensive Outpatient Treatment (SACOT), and Intensive In-Home (IIH) services."
- "These changes were effective April 1, 2017."
- Summarizes changes and notes an IIH rate change
- Of note, "IIH was updated to reflect the legislatively mandated change in team to family ratio from the previous ratio of one team to eight families to the current ratio of one team to twelve families."

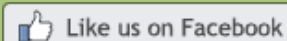

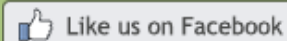
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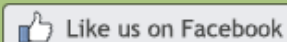
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
