Training #1- Adapting Mental Health Treatment for Youth with IDD

In this session, the definition of developmental disability will be discussed, and specific clinical characteristics will be presented for assessment and differentiating mental health diagnoses. Specific cultural considerations will be presented so clinicians can better understand clients with IDD and confidently address presenting issues. Specific adaptations to individual, family and group therapy will be presented, along with strategies for crucial family supports and care coordination.

Training #2- Family Therapy for Youth with an IDD

When a family includes a child with a developmental disability, that family may possess unique dynamics and face exceptional challenges. Specific cultural and clinical adaptations to family therapy will be introduced and strategies for therapist competency and treatment efficacy will be discussed.
